
Definition: The *leading causes of death* are the causes of death that account for the highest number among all deaths in a population in a given time period. The leading causes of death are presented in rank order and are ranked according to the number of deaths. Ranking the leading causes of death is a common way to look at mortality data and to monitor the burden of various diseases and behaviors.

Summary:

- During 2009-2013, the leading causes of death among Kodiak region Alaska Native people were heart disease, cancer, and unintentional injury. These three leading causes of death accounted for 48.6% of all deaths.
- Kodiak region Alaska Native people share the same three leading causes of death as Alaska Native people statewide.
- COPD mortality rates among Kodiak region Alaska Native people were significantly higher than U.S. Whites (RR=3.3).
